Having reflected on our approach to home learning during lockdown we have taken some steps to provide more structure and support for every pupil. Please find our offer of what we will provide your child at home should they be required to self-isolate or if school is put into lockdown by government.

Class 1 (All approaches will have to take into account staffing levels due to staff health. Mr Richardson is also available to support the learning process.)
