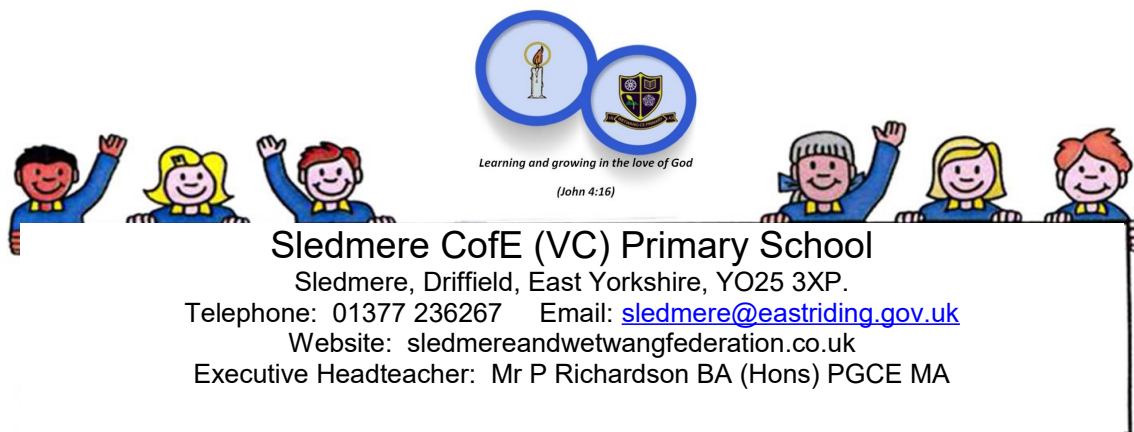

Re: Return to school

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you and your children have had a super break this summer.

I have attached the full coronavirus risk assessment and protocols from the Local Authority and Public Health England. I wanted to summarise so that you can have the key points to hand. We have also created an outbreak contingency plan, which shows enhanced measures that will be taken in the event of another outbreak.

You may have seen the new Government guidance about schools or heard about it in the media. The guidance is that we revert back to fairly normal operating procedures i.e. no bubbles and not much in the way of isolations/ closures. The key thing is that we will be retaining measures such as ventilation, regular hand washing and additional, regular cleaning. Other key points are:

- We shall revert to the usual times of the school day 8.55am-3.30pm. **We will be using the playground, which you are welcome to stand in.** We would ask that you say your goodbyes before the children are led inside promptly by their class teachers at 8.55am.
- At the end of the school day (3.30pm), parents/carers may come onto the **playground** and wait until class teachers dismiss then children. Please ensure you are visible to the class teachers so they can send your child off safely.
- We shall still be keeping numbers of people on site to a minimum and so visitors (including parents and carers) will need an appointment. These can be made via the telephone or via email to sledmere@eastriding.gov.uk
- School lunches - back to normal service in the hall.
- School uniform (including shoes) to be worn please.
- Spare shoes would be useful for the Daily Mile please.
- Collective Worship will be held in the hall. We will let you know about welcoming back in parents/ carers once the children are settled. (Some of our Year 1 pupils have never sat in the hall.)
- Please ensure you have checked your email to log into ParentPay for booking of lunches and After-School Club.

We are all really looking forward to seeing all the children next week.
