As part of our work on **Global Citizenship** we are looking specifically at **Refugees**. We have planned a whole day of learning activities looking at:

- What it means to be a global citizen
- What the term refugee means
- Where refugees come from
- Why people are forced to leave their homes
- What life is like in the UK for refugees (specifically looking at school)



The learning will predominantly involve a combination of video clips, drama, discussion and use of photographs. We would also like to try to raise some money to improve the lives of refugee children via Oxfam. After discussion as a school, we decided that the best way to do this was by means of a sponsored walk involving every child. Next week, your child will be extending the Daily Mile challenge to see if they can complete:

Class 1 – 10 circuits

Class 2 – 20 circuits

Class 3 – 30 circuits
