We **implement** our MFL curriculum through:

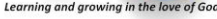
- A curriculum designed to develop not only our children's language skills, but also their love of learning a language.

The **impact** of our French approach is children who are eager and equipped to learn other languages and who enjoy learning about other cultures.

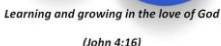
